- Helping scientists work towards solutions that have a real-world impact

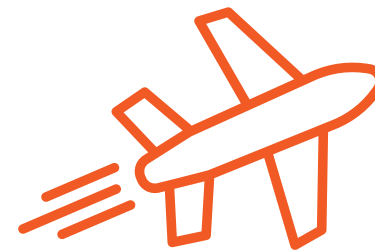


# What are the prizes for the winners?
