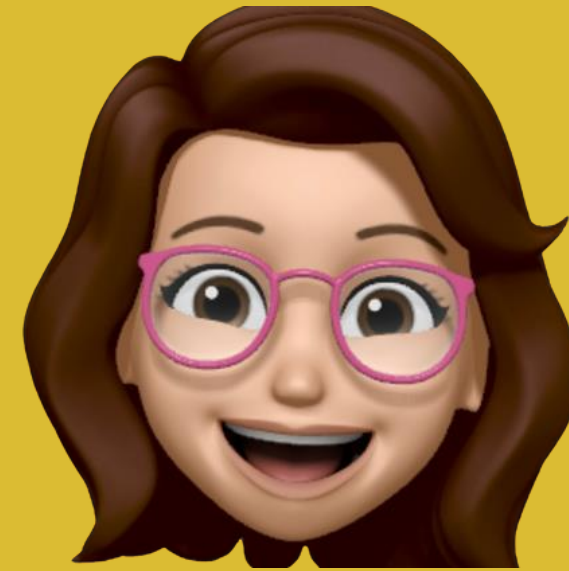

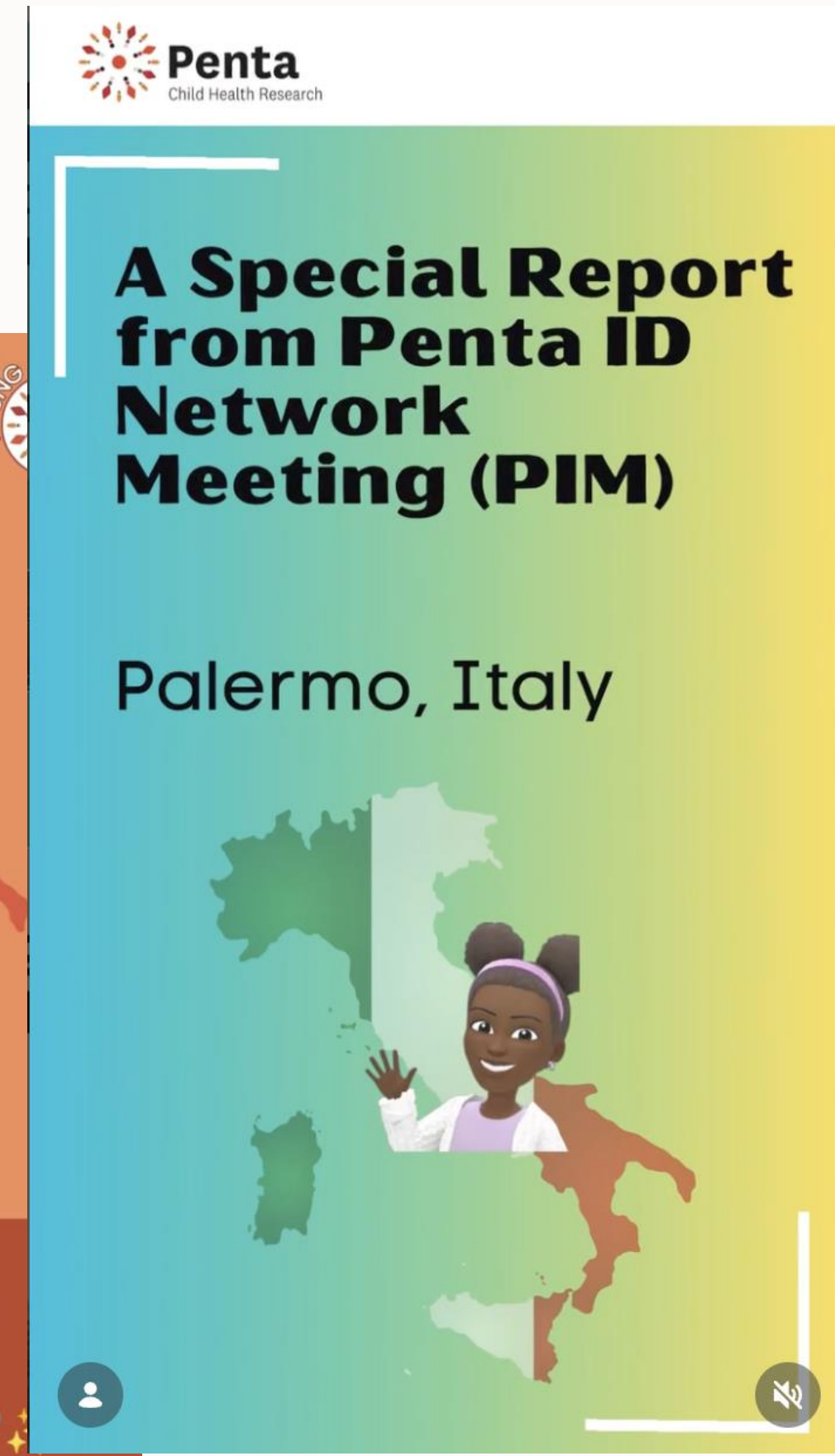


PIM 2026

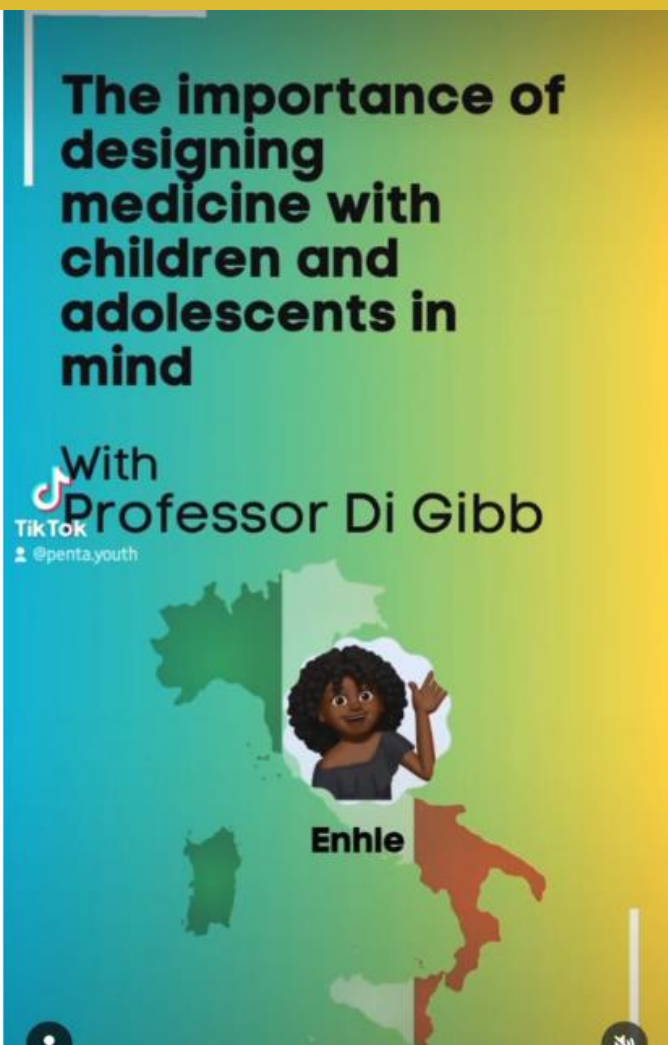
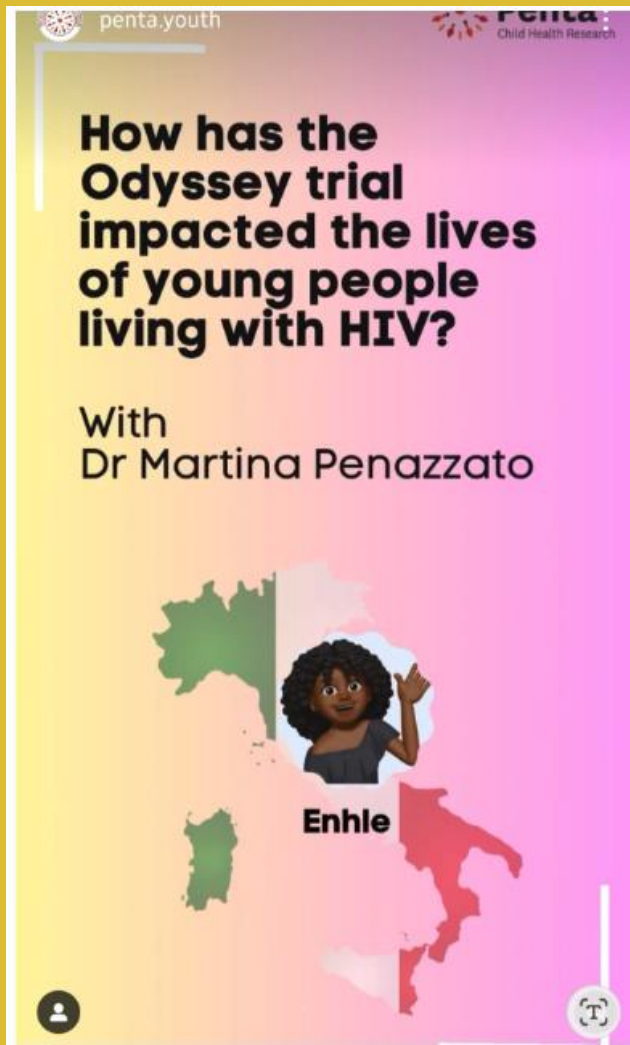
CROI 2024

The CROI 2024 Conference was attended virtually by the Young Reporters. The organic posts reached around 150 people, 80% of whom were new audiences that did not follow us.

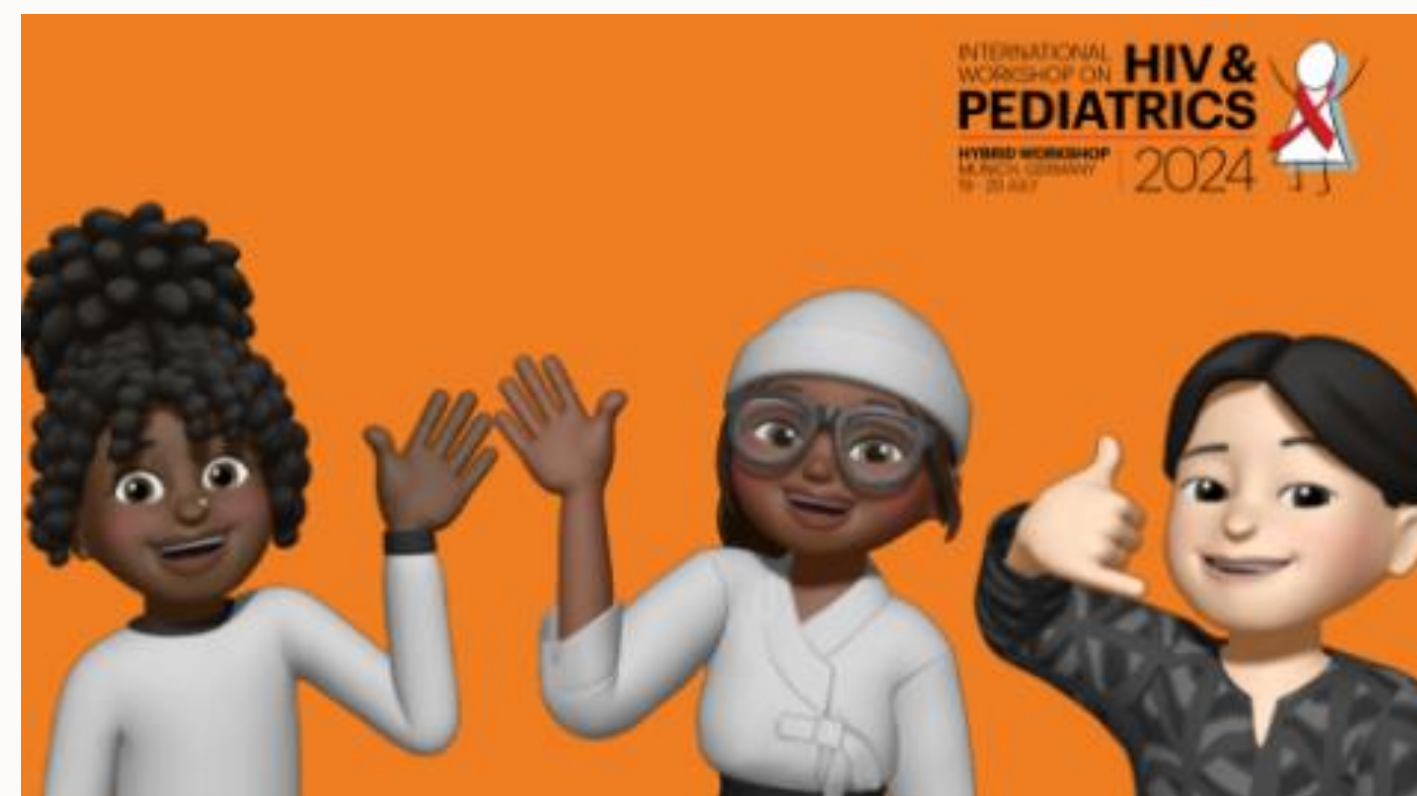


Penta ID Network Meeting

Online Participation in the 3rd **IPHASA** Conference (Kampala, Uganda). Held from December 3-5, 2024, the conference’s theme was *"Equity, Integration and Innovation: For a Sustainable HIV Response to End AIDS in Children by 2030."*

While online participation presented some limitations, the YRs who logged in were able to listen to insightful talks on adolescents and their experiences, which proved to be a useful learning opportunity.

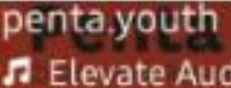

Over 8 training sessions, the Young Reporters learned how to create different types of content and understand scientific information.

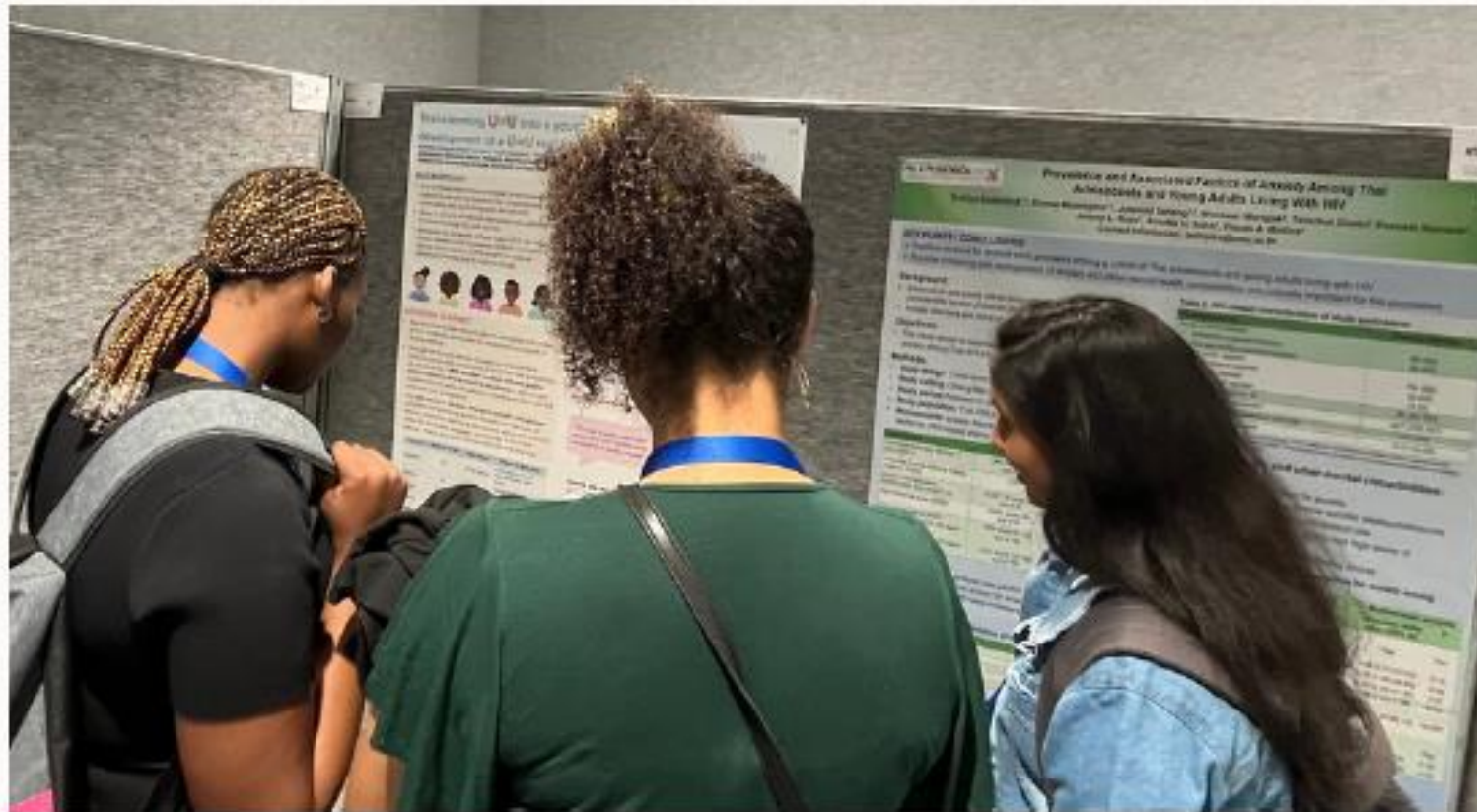
CROI
